



Upper Gastrointestinal Metabolic Research Foundation Grants

The UGIMRF grant aims to promote and encourage research and its presentation by integrated health staff, medical students, surgical registrars and trainees; offering assistance to attend conferences, workshops and/or mentor programs related to the surgical treatment of upper gastrointestinal and metabolic conditions. Grants may be awarded upon completion of research projects to help the financial arrangements related to presentation of the research paper or poster, at either a local or international level.

Applicants must be performing their research or undergoing training with the clinicians associated with the UGIMRF except in exceptional circumstances as determined by the UGIMRF secretariat. There are two grants available. One grant is for Australian and New Zealand conferences/presentations, up to a maximum amount of \$1,500. The other grant is for International conferences/presentations, up to a maximum amount of \$3,000. These grants are to support research and audit projects, not to provide conference attendance alone.

Application Considerations

- Applications for the UGIMRF grant will only be accepted if the research or contributions are of a suitably high standard and are in the field of upper gastrointestinal and metabolic research.
- Application forms are to be completed in full with all supporting documentation available prior to assessment by UGIMRF.
- Decisions will be based on the quality and relevance of each application, potential impact of attendance (i.e. oral presentation vs. attendance only) and locality (national vs. international). Currently, there are two grants per year of up to \$3,000 for international events and \$1,500 for events in Australia/New Zealand.
